## **About us**

Women's Work (Derbyshire) Ltd is a national award winning Charity based in Derbyshire that works holistically with disadvantaged women to offer a confidential support, advice and counselling service. Women's Work has evolved over the past 12 years and now delivers a range of projects aimed at vulnerable women and their families, targeting services at those affected by substance misuse issues, and those with complex needs.

We work in a holistic way to address the causes of certain behaviour. We consider the whole person and not the presenting problem.

We provide an individual package of care and support working with individuals.



## **Below The Radar**

Below The Radar aims to empower the hardest to reach women in our local community. Aimed at those who are isolated, have little peer support or are affected by domestic abuse, a user-defined combination of workshops, counselling, and one-to-one support is used to improve the aspirations and life-chances of the women within the project.

### **The Link Work Project**

The project provides an intensive one to one support for the women and families through informative workshops and family sessions including coffee mornings, parenting classes and leisure activities. The aim of the project is to empower families to develop and improve family relationships.

### **The Little Links Project**

The Little Links Project solely focuses upon the needs of the children. The project aims to inform and support children between 6 –11 years via structured sessions to cope with the effects of living in a household where substance or alcohol misuse occurs and affects their health and well being.

### **The Turn Around Project**

This service is targeted at women at risk of offending and women in the Criminal Justice System to address offending behaviour and prevent re-offending. Project workers support women who are referred via the prison, courts and probation.

## **Counselling Service**

A highly qualified counsellor is available to deliver psychological interventions, in order to enhance attitudes and thinking skills .

### **Confidentiality**

Women's Work operates a strict confidentiality policy. We will only share information with consent. However, we are legally bound to disclose details in any instance where we believe a child is at serious risk of harm.
