WHAT IS TURN AROUND?

A professional service delivered to women by women to address offending behaviour.

The Turn Around Project's ultimate aim is to:

REDUCE RE-OFFENDING!!

By completing an individual assessment which focuses on the 9 resettlement pathways, risk factors that may contribute to or lead to offending behaviour can be identified, and addressed.

RISK FACTORS AND HOW WE CAN HELP

Drug & Alcohol Misuse: aid women to access the necessary treatment and detox provisions.

Accommodation: assist in finding women suitable and sustainable housing.

Financial Issues: meeting with debt counsellors, benefit advisors and negotiating payment plans.

Health: ensure women are aware of their health needs and provide support with arranging and attending appointments.

Family & Relationships: encourage positive and stable relationships and provide family support services.

Skills & Employment: encourage engagement in education, training and employment opportunities.

Attitudes & Behaviour: encourage positive life choices and diversion from offending behaviour.

Domestic Violence & Abuse: ensure the safety of abuse sufferers and provide 1-to-1 support.

Street Sex Work: encourage safe working practices and diversion from street sex work.

Direct access to drug treatment
